#### From the Venerable Master

In this Month's Rite word I would like to quote an article on the All--Seeing Eye. It's an article from a book called Masonry Defined.

The All--Seeing Eye. An important symbol of the Supreme Being, borrowed by the Freemasons from the nations of antiquity. Both the Hebrews and Egyptians appear to have derived its use from that natural inclination of figurative minds to select an organ as the symbol of the function which it is intended peculiarly to discharge. Thus, the foot was often adopted as the symbol of swiftness, the arm of strength, and the hand of fidelity. On the same principle, the open eye was selected as the symbol of watchfulness, and the eye of God as the symbol of divine watchfulness and care of the universe. The use of the symbol in this sense is repeatedly to be found in the Hebrew writers. Thus, the Psalmist says "The eyes of the Lord are upon the righteous, and his ears are open to their cry," which explains a subsequent passage, in which it is said: "Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep."

"Then Moses said to the Lord, O Lord, dost thou sleep or

not? The Lord said unto Moses, I never sleep: but take a cup and fill it with water. Then Moses took a cup and filled it with water, as the Lord commanded him. Then the Lord cast into the heart of Moses the breadth of slumber; so he slept, and the cup fell from his hand, and the water which was therein was spilled. Then Moses awoke from his sleep. Then said God to Moses, I declare by my power, and by my glory, that if I were to withdraw my providence from the heavens and the earth, for no longer a space of time than thou hast slept, they would at once fall to ruin and confusion, like as the cup fell from thy hand."

On the same principle, the Egyptians represented Osiris, their chief deity, by the symbol of an open eye, and placed this hieroglyphic of him in all their temples. His symbolic name, on the monuments, was represented by the eye accompanying a throne, to which was sometimes added an abbreviated figure of the god, and sometimes what has been called a hatchet, but which, I consider, may as correctly be supposed to be a representation of a square.

The All--Seeing Eye may then be considered as a symbol of God manifested in his omnipresence---his guardian and preserving character---to which Solomon alludes in the Book of Proverbs, when he says: "The eyes of Jehovah are in every place, beholding {or, as it might be more faithfully translated, watching} the evil and the good." It is a symbol of the Omnipresent Deity.

#### From the Wise Master

The 27th degree, Knight of the Sun, or Prince Adept, was originally the 28th degree. When the ritual was eventually revised, the two degrees were not only switched in order, but this degree, now the 27th, was significantly shortened. For this second detail, every Scottish Rite mason should be grateful. If Pike had a reputation for being longwinded and wordy, he earned it with this degree. Its original form consumes 219 pages of text! As detailed as the degree re-



mains in its greatly shortened modern form, many times more that what is portrayed is still left to an addendum in the current monitor.

The rather stunning length of this degree is, in some ways, ironic. Many examples are given to emphasize the handful of lessons contained in this degree, one of which concerns the value of symbols themselves. Several ancient takes on *above/below* symbolism are presented along with a number of versions of *left/right/center* symbolism. A great deal is rightly acknowledged as coming from Kabbalah. An additional amount is attributed to Hermeticism.

The above and below imagery is well known from the Hermetic maxim 'as above, so below." The left/right/center symbolism is most recognizable from the three pillars of Kabbalah. In essence, both types address how two parts relate to each other. However, the type of relationship depicted by each symbolic arrangement is different. Above and below are similar to each other. As it is above, so it is below. The relationship between the two parts concerns how and how much they are the same. Below reflects above. Earth reflects heaven. Mankind reflects God.

The *left/right/center* symbolism concerns two sides which are different. They don't reflect but oppose each other, and interact for one reason or another. The relationships between *left* and *right* are generally of two varieties. In one case, the two sides *limit* each other. In the other case, they *complement* each other. Opposites like *fire* and *water*, symbolic *judgment* and *mercy*, are the first type, they counteract each other. Without the temperance each gives to the other, either one might be destructive. Pairs like *wisdom* and *understanding*, on the other hand, interact with each other. One doesn't mitigate the effects of the other. They are interdependent, each providing what the other needs and doesn't have. *Wisdom* needs to be understood and *understanding* needs wisdom to comprehend. The center column is not a third influence, but reflects a perfected relationship between the two sides which is harmonious and balanced.

Masons apply this understanding to their relationships. As mentors and role models, we are to lead by example. As laborers together we strive to complement each other.

When I started putting my articles together, I thought that I would shy-away from the usual histories. Being October, however, I decided a while back to print this particular "Ghost Story" now, one which still haunts Freemasonry to this day. The subject is the "Taxil Hoax" (of which I believe all Freemasons should be aware), and is given a brief yet quite excellent treatment in the book "Freemasonry for Dummies", by Christopher Hodapp, PM, 33°, KT, © 2005 by Wiley Publishing, Inc., ISBN-13: 1978-0-7645-9796-1). The following is directly from Chapter 18, pages 297 through 299 of the 2005 printing of the book; chapter and page numbers may be different in later printings. If you don't have this book yet, get it: it's good!

#### Tower, Language, and Management of Humans

In our last two articles, we discussed the Great Flood or Noah's Flood, which submerged the entire earth and wiped out all of humanity except for Noah and his family floating on top of the waters in an ark.

After the waters subsided and Noah's family could leave the ark, the worldwide population consisted of eight people: Noah and his wife, their three sons with their respective wives. Since women are little regarded by the Bible authors, we don't know any of the wives' names. There is no indication that any of the named men may have had multiple wives.

Genesis Chapter 10 lists Noah's son Japheth as having seven sons. Of the seven sons, two are listed as having children, totaling seven named grandsons. Verse 5 suggests that they went on to populate "the isles of the Gentiles", most likely in the Mediterranean Sea.

Noah's son Ham had four sons. Three of them are shown as having sons. In total, Ham has 21 grandsons, plus two great grandsons are listed.

#### **Nimrod**

One of Ham's grandsons is Nimrod, "the mighty [warrior] / hunter before the Lord". Bible historians have different ideas who Nimrod actually was, or whether the was a person at all. The Bible says nothing about the game he hunted.

Unless that game was real estate. Nimrod is connected with the building of cities of Babel, Erech, Accad, Calneh, in the land of Shinar, which today is known as Mesopotamia. In addition the cities of Asshur, Nineveh, Rehoboth, Calah, and Resen are listed. They lay to the north of Mesopotamia. The Sumerian, Assyrian, Akkadian, and Babylonian civilizations developed in these areas.

#### Canaan

We talked about the descendants of Canaan last month. Canaan's descendants are connected with the cities of Sidon, Gerar, Gaza, Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboim, and Lasha, all of which are in or near Bible lands . Also listed are the names of early non-Israelite tribes, including Jebusites, Amorites, Girgasites, Hivites, Arkites, and Sinites. Three more tribes, the Arvadites, Zemarites, and Hamathites, were the families that made up the Canaanites, who occupied the Promise Land centuries later when Moses led the Israelites there.

#### **Mizraim**

Ham's son Mizraim had seven sons. They migrated southwestward into the lands of Arabia and Egypt. The descendants of Mizraim son, Casluhim, are said the be the origin of the Philistines, who struggled for years with the Israelites in the days of the Judges and King David. They called their land Philistina. It is known today as Palestine.

As you read on in the Bible, two things become apparent. The Bible is Israelite-centric. And a majority of the civilizations and tribes listed above, are at one time or other, conquerers or opponents of the Israelite people.

#### Shem

Genesis lists the names of five sons of Noah's son, Shem. Aran had four sons. The text shows that Arphaxhad had one son, Salah, who had one son, Eber. Eber, in turn had two sons, Peleg and Joktan. These were the great-grandsons of Shem.

For the most part, Genesis 10 adds two generations after each of Noah's sons. Verses 22 through 25 go out five generations. So what? This is a break in the pattern of the text. It calls our attention to something important about Shem's descendants.

#### The Earth was Divided

The text says Joktan had 13 named sons. Peleg, has one son in the next chapter, but our attention is drawn to a mysterious phrase, connected to Peleg: "for in his days was the earth divided". What does that mean? It depends on who you ask.

In Hebrew, the name Peleg means "division" In Greek, the name is Phalek or Phaleg. Here is another example of a person's name connected with a deed or event. Traditionally, the division spoken of is found in the following chapter, Genesis II, the story of the Tower of Babel and the confounding of the people's language.

Some Creationists interpret this verse as referring to the supercontinent of Pangaea being split into the modern continents. The traditional Bible timeline, which places the Creation as happening in 4004 BCE, places Noah's Flood around 2350 BCE. Six generations times 40 years, estimates Peleg's division of the earth happening around 240 years later, say, 2110 BCE, about 4,000 years ago.

Geologists say that the supercontinent of Pangaea began to break apart about 200 million years ago. They call it a "supercontinent" because all of the separate continents we know today were stuck together into one big land mass. Think about it: The cruise ship industry might never have existed if Pangaea had stayed together.

#### Tower of Babel

The Tower of Babel is one of the best-known stories in the Hebrew Bible. Genesis II verse I says, "And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech."

What was this language? Some Jewish and Christian traditions suggest it was the Adamic language, the one Adam and Eve spoke. According to Ethiopian and Eritrean traditions, the ancient Semitic language of Ge'ez was the language of Adam. We have a number of extant non-Bible texts written in Ge'ez, also known as Classical Ethiopic. It is also the liturgical language of Ethiopian and Eritrean Christian churches.

"And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; and they dwelt there." Gen 11:2.

Who are we talking about? We know the land of Shinar refers to Mesopotamia, so this sounds like Nimrod, the mighty warrior / hunter / real estate mogul, and the descendants of Noah that chose to followed him.

"And they said one to another, Go to, let us make brick, and burn them thoroughly. And they had brick for stone, and slime had they for mortar." Gen 11:3.

Brick or stone? That depends on the local geology. Mesopotamia is a big river basin. There was plenty of mud but no deposits of stone nearby. So the builders used what was available. The word "slime" refers to bitumen.

Why would the authors mention this? Because they came from a place where big buildings were made of stone, like the Levant. Remember that these stories were oral traditions that were finally written down in the final centuries BCE.

"And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth." Gen 11:4.

"And the Lord came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men builded. And the Lord said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do." Gen 11:5-6

It looks like Humanity 2.0 is getting into mischief, just like their antediluvian predecessors (Humanity 1.0.) The text only hints at why the tower offends God, "whose top may reach unto heaven".

Tradition suggests that the tower is an act of defiance, that humans assumed a right to access the divine realm; or that the tower builders worshipped the a different god, in this case the Mesopotamian goddess, Innana. Josephus suggested that Nimrod was a ruthless dictator and the tower was the product of severe forced or slave labor.

"Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech. So the Lord scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city." Gen 11:7-8.

"Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the Lord did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the Lord scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth." Gen 11:9

#### Moral of the Story

Babel is the Hebrew name for the city and empire of Babylon. The native Akkadian name of the city was Bāb-ilim, meaning "gate of God". Alternatively, the name Babel may come from the Hebrew verb bālal, meaning to jumble or to confuse, after the Lord distorted the common language of humankind.

When you read verses I and 9, you get the point of the story. This is an etiology, an explanation of why the different peoples of the world live in separate places, each speaking their own language. Then we recall the phrase used in Genesis 10, verses 5, 20, and 31: "These are the sons of [Japheth, Ham, Shem], after their families, after their tongues, in their countries, and in their nations". This shakeup was bound to happen.

#### **Z**iggurats

Archaeologists have identified the ruins of ancient buildings called "ziggurats" which are pyramid-stepped temple towers. They were built with mud bricks and an exterior surface of baked mud bricks. Baked bricks are rain and wind resistant.

Unlike the pyramids of Egypt, ziggurats had no internal chambers. They were usually square or rectangular, averaging either 170 feet square or 125 × 170 feet at the base. Approximately 25 ziggurats are known, being equally divided among Sumer, Babylonia, and Assyria. They were built from approximately 2200 until 500 BCE. That fits with the traditional Bible timeline.

People ascended the ziggurat by an exterior triple stairway or by a spiral ramp. But for almost half of the known ziggurats, no means of ascent has been discovered. The sloping sides and terraces were often landscaped with trees and shrubs. A famous example was the Hanging Gardens of Babylon, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world.

The legendary Tower of Babel has been popularly associated with the Etemenanki ziggurat of the great temple of Marduk in Babylon.

The Apocryphal Book of Jubilees informs us that the Tower of Babel took 43 years to build and stood 5,433 cubits tall. That is 8,021 feet or 1.5 miles. Today, the world's tallest building is the Burj Khalifa in Dubai. It stands 2,717 feet or half a mile tall.

Unfortunately for the ambitious Babel builders, they still had a long way to go. Modern humans have been all the way to the moon, landed machines on Mars, and sent satellites into the solar system. But we have not yet reached the heavenly realm.

#### Leo Taxil and the Great Hoax!

Gabriel Antoine Jogand-Pagès was born in Marseilles, France, in 1854, and [having changed his name] at a very young age, he fell in love with the life of being a con artist. At the wise old age of 25, Taxil decided to capitalize on the wave of anti-Catholic sentiment in France at the time, and began writing a series of satires, pamphlets, and pornographic stories against the Church. In 1881, he joined a Masonic lodge. After his first degree, he was quickly expelled for his repeated run-ins with the law and other publishing outrages. Taxil needed to find a new and better source of income and fun. Peeved over being chucked from the lodge, Leo conceived a masterful hoax, and this time took aim at both Catholics and Freemasons.

In 1885, he trotted off to a Catholic church and confessed his sins to the local priest. He even threw in a completely fictitious confession to a murder, as a joke to test the confidentiality of the confessional. Next, as a newly minted and "outraged" Catholic, he began writing a series of fictitious exposés of the secret rituals of the Freemasons. Never mind that he had only experienced the first degree. What he didn't know, he made up. In short order, he published *The Three-Point Brothers*, *The Anti-Christ and the Origin of Masonry*, *The Cult of the Great Architect*, and *The Masonic Assassins*.

To his great amusement, Taxil became the darling of the Catholic hierarchy and was granted a private audience in Rome with Pope Leo XII. The pope declared himself to be Taxil's biggest fan and wanted more books and more exposés of the Masons, a situation which Taxil found to be absolutely hilarious, as well as financially lucrative. He was running dry but soon created what would become a story that has long outlived him.

Taxil's most fanciful invention was a version of Freemasonry he claimed was called *Palladism* or *Luciferian High-Masonry*. He wrote that Palladism was created and directed from Charleston, South Carolina, where it was founded by Albert Pike. According to his increasingly bizarre story, Palladism was a co-ed version of Masonry that organized sexual orgies and Satan worship among its members. Albert Pike, whom Taxil gave the title Supreme Pontiff of Universal Freemasonry, supposedly directed 23 Supreme Confederated Councils of the World by passing instructions to them through a woman named Diana Vaughan. According to Taxil, Ms. Vaughan was able to blow the whistle on Pike and his unholy band of Satan worshipers when she escaped the fiendish clutches of a Palladian lodge.

There wasn't a speck of truth in his entire absurd and convoluted tale, apart from a real lady named Diana Vaughan who typed his manuscripts, but the public ate it up. Fortunately for Taxil, Albert Pike had died in 1891, so there wasn't much of a chance of a slander lawsuit from across the sea. So, he could gleefully write that Pike, the Luciferian Pope, met with Lucifer every Friday at 3:00 p.m. (We're left to wonder if this was a

late-in-the-day, three-martini lunch.) Palladian lodges engaged in devil worship, ritual sex, and any other sacrileges Taxil could think of.

Meanwhile, Taxil's popular works about nonexistent female Palladian lodges were feverishly embroidered by others. The Bishop of Grenoble asserted that these female lodges were harems for the male lodges, while Jesuit Bishop Leon Meurin wrote in his Synagogue of Satan that everything about Freemasonry was Satanic, including aprons, symbols, signs and handshakes.

On April 19, 1897, Taxil rented the auditorium of the Paris Geographic Society and filled the hall with a carefully invited guest list of free-thinkers, Catholics, and the press. In a long presentation, he dropped the bomb on them all: Everything he had written had been a carefully designed hoax, specifically intended to humiliate the Catholic Church for being so easily manipulated. The gathering erupted in competing clamors of both laughter and anger, depending on whose ox was being gored. His 33-page confession was printed in the papers the following week, and it was the talk of Paris. He had made a fat wad of cash with his books and thumbed his nose at both the Masons and the Church. He left Paris and retired to a very nice country house where he died in 1907.

More than a hundred years after his confession, Taxil's quotes about Luciferian Masonry and his deceitful misquoting of Albert Pike's writings still get trotted out in new anti-Masonic works. Jack Harris, J. Edward Decker, James Holly, Gary H. Kah, William Schnoebelen, Jack Chick, and even Pat Robertson (who should really know better, as his own father was a Freemason) have all published anti-Masonic books over the last several decades that use portions of Taxil's self-confessed lies. Leo the liar is long dead, but his practical joke lives on.

#### **Montery Scottish Rite Club**
